Through all the struggles of two cancer diagnoses and treatment, Candlelighters Childhood Cancer Foundation of Nevada gave me and my family hope that everything

would be ok. No one wants to hear the awful words, "you have cancer," especially hearing it twice before the age of 18. At just one month old, I was diagnosed with Hepatoblastoma, a form of liver cancer. At nine months old, I received a lifesaving liver transplant. My family knew I only had about
