THE GIAMANCO FAMILY

Candlelighters first met the Giamanco family when their youngest child, Preston, was diagnosed at age two and underwent 21 weeks of chemo and a kidney removal. Preston and his older sisters participated in Candlelighters events. In the Fall of 2019, their middle child Emilee was diagnosed with DIPG - which has less than a 1% survival rate, and sadly Emilee gained her angel wings in 2021. Emily's light continues to shine through a special "I'll always be there for you" Fund used for other families on their childhood cancer journey. We honor their strength, courage, and resilience as we remember Emilee's love and light.

THE DERBY FAMILY

Zariya was diagnosed at 18 months old with cancer of the liver, a 1 in a million diagnosis that affects children three and younger.
